Important Safety Information

Safety is important, as is the comfort and enjoyment onboard for all our passengers on the *Isle of Inisheer*. We have a number of safety procedures which must be followed at all times. These are in place for your benefit.

Safety on Board

We operate to the highest safety standards, as set down by the **International Maritime Organisation (IMO)** and are constantly monitored by the regulatory authorities in each country.

Please observe the following simple safety rules:

- Please listen carefully to all announcements.
- Unaccompanied children (under 18 years old) are not permitted on outside decks.
- Note outside decks may be slippery when wet.

Assembly Station

- When moving around the ship, please note the **Assembly Station** signs, and read the safety messages on these signs.
- Familiarise yourself with instructions on how to put on life jackets.

These instructions are posted around the ship.

- Dispose of litter only in the bins provided. Do not litter the sea.

Remember, we're here to ensure you enjoy your trip with us.

If you have any questions please do not hesitate to ask a member of our staff, or talk to us at our Reception Desk (Deck 7).

Vehicle Loading Procedure

Loading vehicles onto *Isle of Inisheer* is a complex procedure. To achieve the best loading arrangements please be aware that a vehicle that has checked in after you may be loaded before you.

Embarkation

On arrival on the car deck, a crew member will direct you to a parking space. Before leaving your vehicle please ensure you have applied the hand brake and left the car in gear. If you are driving a motorhome or towing a caravan please ensure all portable gas cylinders are safely secured and turned off. Due to safety and security regulations, access to your vehicle at sea is not permitted. Please remember to take any luggage you may require during the crossing, along with any valuables and medication. Lock your vehicle. Ensure your car alarm motion sensor is switched off. Given the short duration of your sailing, animals should be comfortable when left in your vehicle. Remember though to leave water and enough ventilation.

NO SMOKING



Smoking (including electronic cigarettes) is only permitted in the designated smoking areas on the outer decks. Please take care when disposing of cigarettes. Use the bins provided. Don't litter the sea.

Access and Facilities



If you or a member of your party has reduced mobility or has any special requirements, please bring this to the attention of our crew at the Reception Desk on Deck 7, who will be happy to assist you. On board *Isle of Inisheer* there are designated wheelchair accessible areas including toilets (Decks 7&8) and a lift (Blue lift from the car decks to Decks 7&8). A hearing loop is also installed at our Reception Desk (Deck 7).

Disembarkation

Please do not proceed to your vehicle until disembarkation announcements have been made. Please make yourselves comfortable and await instructions. Do not start your vehicle's engine or move your vehicle until instructed to do so and please follow all directions given by ship's crew. Please take your personal belongings with you when disembarking the ship.

Check Your Stairways & Elevators

To help you locate your vehicle at disembarkation time, please remember the Car Deck number and the colour stairs / lift used as you leave your car. Please appreciate and will assist in a smoother disembarkation for all.

Animals are not permitted in the passenger area with the exception of approved Assistance Dogs wearing a regulation coloured harness or jacket.

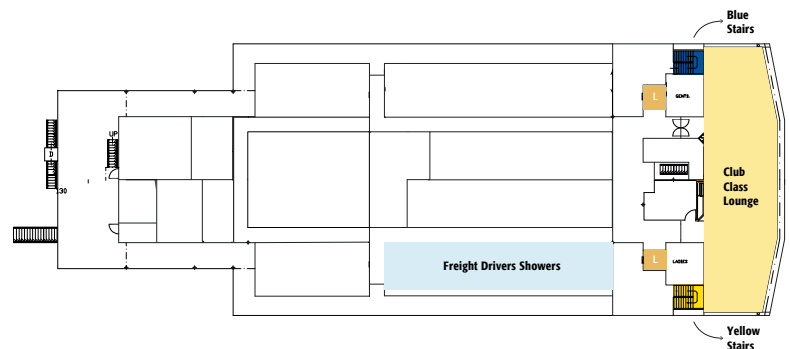

Deck Plan

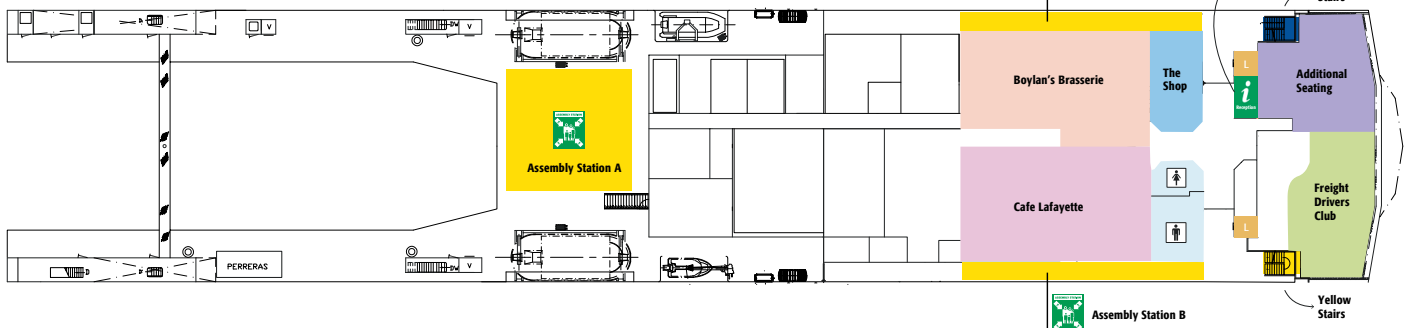
